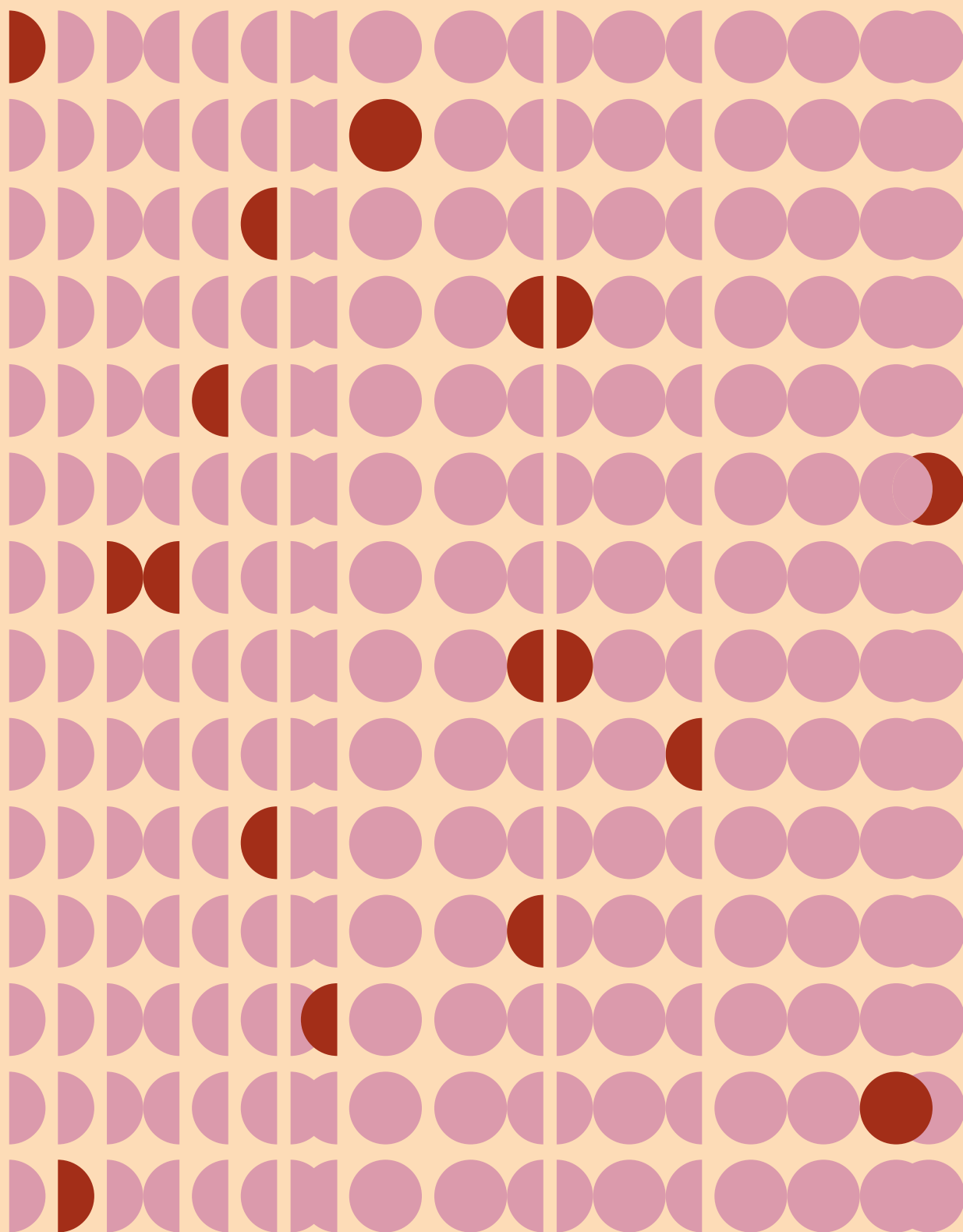

PRODUCER

Together with Lorenz Uhl, he wrote the screenplay *Söder*, which was screened at renowned festivals such as Clermont-Ferrand and Palm Springs. His feature debut script *Save Our Souls* is currently in production.

DIRECTOR

Ella Lee Stanley (2003) is a German-Irish screenwriter, director and actress. She grew up in Berlin and first appeared in front of the camera at the age of 12 in the Netflix hit *DARK* and has since appeared in many productions. She has been studying screenwriting and directing at the Filmakademie Vienna since 2022.

Nina, eight years old, goes on a sudden vacation with her mother Aline to the Corsican coast. Her parents are divorced, and Nina doesn't spend much time with her mother, who is very distant toward her. Aline is on the island to look for Anaïs, whom she knew when she lived in Corsica before moving to Italy. By the end of the vacation, Nina realizes that her mother, too, is suffering being—not the radiant, untouchable creature she had always imagined.



PRODUCER

Paolo Sideri (1997) is an independent producer, film director and film editor. He focuses on the discovery of young talent and projects with a strong visual identity. He produced *La Moto* (SIC@SIC – Venice 2025), *Come i camosci* (Trento FF 2023) and the documentary series *The Witness Eye* (Erasmus+). He is the writer and producer of *La Controra* (2021), selected in over twenty international festivals.

DIRECTOR

Valentina Pietrarca (Campobasso, 2000) is a director and visual artist, graduated from the Civica Scuola di Cinema L. Visconti in Milan. She works as a 1st AD and writer for film criticism magazines and collaborates with film festivals and screenings. As a co-founder of the collective Onirica, she produces independent short films, including her directorial debut, *L'Ornitologa* (2024). Her research focuses on the queer body and its relationship with metamorphosis and nature, explored through video and installation practices. She lives and works in Venice, where she is pursuing a Master's degree in Visual Arts at IUAV University.

COMPANY

Fuoristrada is an independent production company founded in 2025 by **Paolo Sideri** and Matteo Giampetruzzi. Its editorial line focuses on supporting authors with a strong and distinctive cinematic vision. The first project they produced was *La Moto*, directed by Giampetruzzi, which premiered in the SIC@SIC Competition of the 82nd Venice Film Festival's Critics' Week 2025.

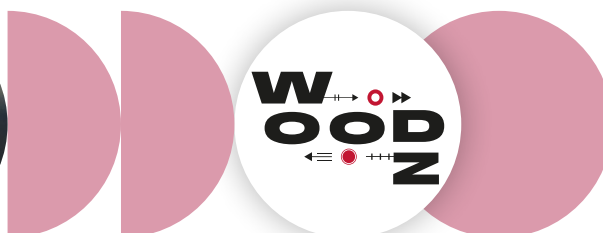
VANCULETI

Dražen Krešić

CROATIA



In an abandoned village, two elderly neighbors, Manda and Ljubica, live simple lives, bound by a rivalry over a long-forgotten reason. Both wear vanculets; iconic traditional scarves used as head coverings. One hot summer day, Ljubica is bitten by a snake and screams for help. Though hesitant, Manda rushes to her aid, extracting the venom from the wound and bandaging it with her vanculet, releasing her long gray hair. Vanculets become a tool of connection, a proof of reconciliation, and ultimately a reminder of how much the women need each other every single day.



PRODUCER

Noa Nikolić and **David Uranjek** were born in 2002 and 2001 respectively. They are majoring in Film and TV Production at the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. **Noa** line produced two feature documentaries: *Feast of the Wolf* (PÖFF 2025) and *My Dad's Lessons* (Big Stamp award at ZagrebDox 2025). **David** worked on Nova TV as assistant director on shows *Masterchef*, *Dancing with the Stars*, and *Got Talent*. He also produced student opera *Amphitryon*, performed at the Croatian National Theatre (HNK) in Zagreb. His graduation film was shown in over 10 festivals.

DIRECTOR

Dražen Krešić is born in Dubrovnik in 1987. After completing secondary school, he moved to Zagreb, where he created his first works in the field of dramatic arts. He later relocated to Sarajevo, where he enrolled in the Academy of Performing Arts, majoring in Theatre, Film, TV, and Radio Directing. Later, he earned a master's degree in Theatre Directing from the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. He is currently working on the short fiction film *Guardian Angel*, which is in post-production, along with several theatre and radio projects.

COMPANY

Woodz Production was founded in October 2022 with the goal of developing and promoting engaging artistic projects. With an already established network of collaborators, the company seeks to promote the work of young authors while also developing original ideas that can resonate with both artistic and more commercially oriented audiences. The company currently has numerous projects in pre-production, while two minority co-productions are in post-production phase.

A wild plan that will test the bond between two very different friends.



PRODUCER

Antonio Llana (Oviedo, 1999) is an emerging film producer from Asturias, Spain. Since 2023, he has worked independently, developing fiction and documentary projects. In 2025, he was awarded three individual audiovisual grants from the Government of the Principality of Asturias (*Casa de Verano*, *Un golpe de amor*, *Falso Azabache*). He is currently co-producing *La Soterraña* with Cristina Hergueta (**Garde Films**) and Freews Producciones. His work has been selected and awarded at the Gijón International Film Festival (FICX), and is included in the Laboral Cinemateca distribution catalogue.



DIRECTOR

Ana G. Sierra began her career as a fiction screenwriter at Grupo Mediapro, working in teams led by Marc Vigil, Sergio Sarria, Carmen Ortiz, and Iván Escobar. Her first series, *Express*, is a family thriller for Netflix. In 2025, she wrote the documentary *No hables por mí* for Movistar+ and developed the series *Una serie de gente* with Nanouk Films. She currently works at Good Mood as a development screenwriter. Her passion for independent cinema led her to take part in workshops with Oliver Laxe and Jonás Trueba, as well as festivals and labs such as FICX, Novos Cinemas, CIMA Impulsa, Abycine, Emergente Cine Lab, and Dones Visuals.



COMPANY

Garde Films is a film and art production company based in Cáceres, with an office in Madrid, led by producer Cristina Hergueta. The company specializes in author-driven films — fiction, non-fiction, experimental, feature-length, short films, and video art — with a handcrafted, artisanal approach: “auteur films made with care and dedication by a small, fully involved team.” She has produced films such as *Los inocentes*, *Gorria*, and *Karen*, selected at Cannes Directors' Fortnight, San Sebastián, CPH:DOX, and Visions du Réel.

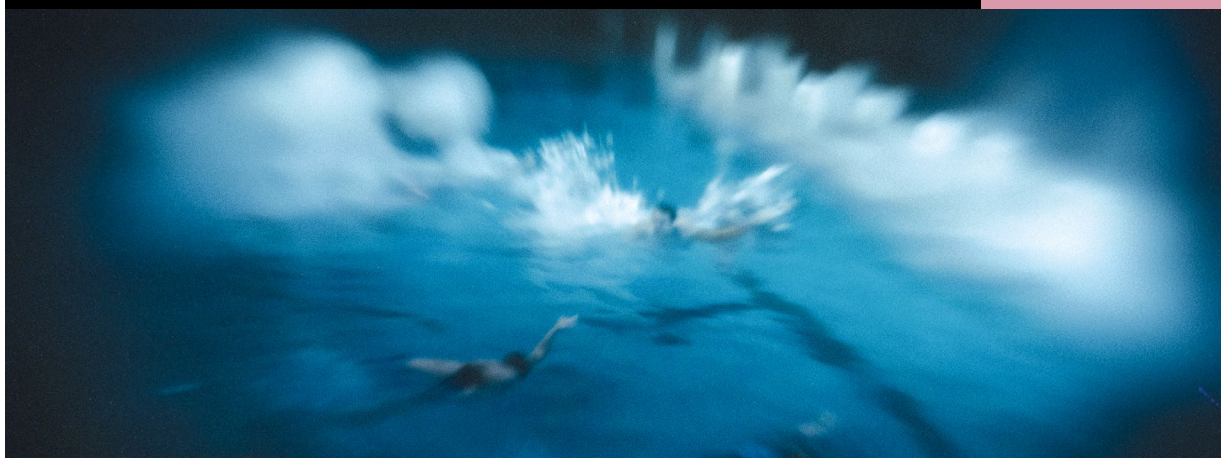

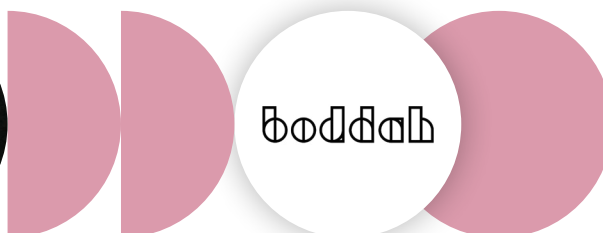
PURITY

PRODUCER

Anna Szijártó studied film history and theory at Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest. She earned a master's in line producing from ESCAC Barcelona in 2012, then joined Kinopravda as production manager for award-winning commercials and music videos. In early 2020 she turned her focus to cinema, having produced four acclaimed short films including *Diamond Beauty* (multiple award winner).

Gábor Osváth is Hungarian film producer, who runs the companies Filmfabriq and **Boddah**. His most recent co-productions include the feature animation *Tony, Shelly and the Magic Light*, the Canadian-Hungarian *Blue Heron* and the upcoming live-action feature films *Backwoods* and *Cowgirl*.

DIRECTOR

Born in 2000 in Budapest, Hungary, **Vilmos Heim** graduated in Film Studies from Eötvös Loránd University. His first short film *My Father's Son* (2024) was selected for numerous international festivals. He was selected for Vienna Shorts Talent Days and received a pitching award from In The Palace ISFF with his short *Cry a Wolf* (2026), which is currently in post-production. His latest project, *Purity* was also introduced in Baltic Pitching Forum where he received a special prize from Yle.

COMPANY

Boddah is a film production company and artists' hub, which was founded by director Bálint Szimler, cinematographer Marcell Rév and producer **Gábor Osváth**. The collective's most recent credits include the feature films *Lesson Learned* (Locarno 2024) and *Blue Heron* (Locarno 2025, Toronto 2025), as well as the back-to-back Annecy Crystal-winning short animations *Amok* and *27* (co-productions with Romania and France, respectively) - the latter of which also won the Palme d'Or at Cannes in 2023.

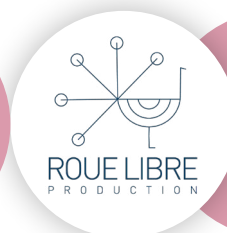
PRODUCER

David Borgeaud was born and raised in Switzerland. After completing a degree in literature at the University of Lausanne, he moved to Belgium to study film production. Graduating in 2013, he founded **Roue Libre Production** the following year, with the ambition to support filmmakers from his generation over the long term. In the last twelve years, he has produced twenty-one films and is currently developing four Belgian majority feature projects, all with directors whose work he has previously produced. In parallel, he was Head of Industry at the Namur International Francophone Film Festival (FIFF) from 2018 to 2024, and has served since 2020 as a reader for the French speaking Belgian Center for Cinema and Audiovisual Media.



DIRECTOR

Born in 1980 in the province of Liège, **Christophe Prédari** first studied occupational therapy and worked with blind and visually impaired people, helping them regain autonomy in their daily movements. Although he deeply valued that work, his true passion lay in cinema. In 2008, he entered INSAS film school in Brussels to study directing. His graduation film, *Human Warmth* (2012), was selected in over eighty festivals. His first professional short, *A Father* (2022), was screened at more than forty international festivals and was broadcast on RTBF.



COMPANY

Founded in 2014, **Roue Libre Production** has notably produced *Kapitalistis* (2017) awarded at Locarno and nominated for the Magritte, César and European Film Awards, as well as the first season of the web series *The Y Theory*. In 2021, the company released its first feature film, *Mother Schmuckers*, which screened at around thirty festivals, including Sundance. Initially focused on Belgian majority projects, **Roue Libre Production** is now opening up to international co-productions, with ongoing collaborations in Switzerland, France and Poland. The company continues to explore the creative possibilities that co-production can offer.

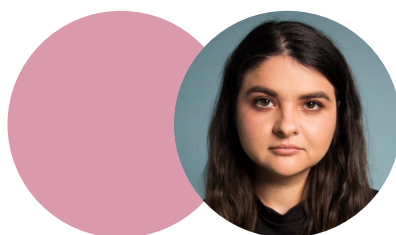
THE CENSUS

UKRAINE



Vera, a quiet and modest twenty-year-old, works as a census taker during the country's first national population census. On cold winter evenings, she must go door to door, recording data about the residents and inadvertently becoming a witness to the lives of others. The irony is that while visiting countless homes, Vera has no place of her own. Her situation becomes even more precarious when she is evicted from her dormitory.



PRODUCER

Valeria Sochyvets is an Ukrainian film producer and director with a BA from the Kyiv National University of Theatre, Cinema and Television. She is a member of the Ukrainian Film Academy, the European Film Academy, and the Ukrainian Oscar Committee. In 2015, she founded **CUC** to support and produce auteur Ukrainian films. Her portfolio includes 13 short films and 4 features, selected at top festivals, earning over 30 awards and nominations. She produced *La Palisiada*, which won the FIPRESCI Award at IFFR 2023 and was nominated for the EFA Discovery Award.



DIRECTOR

Olena Podolianko is a Ukrainian director and screenwriter. She has been active in the film industry since 2015. She co-directed the docufiction film *It Is Quiet Here* (2022), which premiered at the Sarajevo Film Festival. In 2023, **Olena** joined the Berlinale Talents Sarajevo Edition as a participant in the Director's Summit program. Her project *The Census* was selected for the SoliDare artistic residency (Slovakia). Olena is also the co-writer of the feature film *Hard Sub*, developed in collaboration with director Novruz Himet, and selected for the Torino Feature Lab at the Torino Film Festival.



COMPANY

Created in 2013, **Contemporary Ukrainian Cinema** is a collective dedicated to promoting contemporary Ukrainian cinema. It brings together filmmakers, producers, and curators to support independent creation, showcase engaged works, and foster international exchange, while highlighting the artistic diversity and current realities of Ukraine.

A helicopter takes off in a swirl of snow; a line of pickups is parked along a mountain road. Adam, fifteen, follows his older brother up an Alpine pass to block migrants from crossing. Deep in the mountains, engulfed by a roaring blizzard, they witness a tragedy that could shift everything.



PRODUCERS

Romain Rampillon is a producer, director, and cinematographer. He co-founded **Avant la Nuit** with **Benjamin Costes**, **Thibaut Amri**, and **Antoine Guide**. As a producer, he is interested in the entire creative process, from shooting setups to production methods.

Thibaut Amri is a French-Tunisian producer and director. He studied at the University of Montpellier and later at La Fémis through the Atelier Ludwigsburg–Paris program. Among others, *Khmerica*, his first documentary as a director, is co-produced by Rithy Panh and premiered at Visions du Réel 2025.

DIRECTOR

Benjamin Costes holds a Master's degree in the Philosophy of Mathematics as well as a specialized Master's in screenwriting and production from La Sorbonne university. In 2021, he co-founded the production company **Avant la Nuit**, through which he has developed and produced around fifteen projects in France and abroad (Cambodia, Algeria, Morocco). Alongside his work as a producer, he is also a writer. He notably wrote *La Rue Mère*, a feature-length documentary, which received development funding from the French CNC, *Phil*, a fiction feature film, and *French Bear*, a short fiction film, both of which receiving development support from Montpellier Métropole.

COMPANY

Avant la Nuit is an independent production company founded by four producers, directors, and cinematographers. Conceived as a laboratory, it brings together diverse perspectives and expertise around a shared desire for auteur-driven cinema that engages with the world, between fiction and reality. Its filmography includes *We Are Family* (Grand Prize in Gérardmer 2025), *Khmerica* (2025), *Until the Orchid Blooms* (2024) and *The House is on Fire, Might as Well Get Warm* (Directors' Fortnight, 2023). Upcoming projects include *Jusqu'où la forêt*, *Végapolis* and *La Rue Mère*.

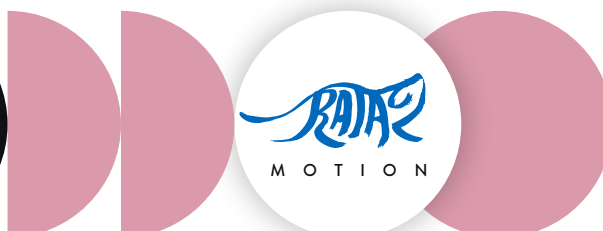
ODD BIRDS

Veera Lamminpää

FINLAND



Taxidermized birds burst into song in this poetic, darkly comic stop-motion musical. From their display case in a Finnish school, they reflect on the pecking order, belonging, and the rule of the strongest. The birds' song draws strange parallels between the laws of nature and the unwritten rules of school life. The film addresses the serious themes of loneliness, bullying and insecurities, with a surreal twist. Finally, the music ends on a hopeful note: we are all enough as we are – even the odd birds.



PRODUCER

Janne J. Vanhanen produced the short film *Fish River Anthology* (2024) and is one of the creators of *The Short Fuse* (*Räjähdysherkkä*), a popular youth drama series for the Finnish Broadcasting Company. He has extensive production experience, including as a partner and board member at the production company Vallilan Vaara, and as a production manager at Cocoa Mediaproductio, Finland's largest commercial production company. **Jenni Pulli** has produced several short films and has previously collaborated with **Veera** as the producer of her short film *Great Emotions* (2024). She holds a Master's degree in Film and Television Producing from Aalto University. She has an extensive background working as a production manager on feature films and TV series.

DIRECTOR

Veera Lamminpää is a screenwriter, director, and animator based in Helsinki, Finland. She holds a Master's degree in Film Directing from Aalto University and has over a decade of experience in the film industry. Her work includes several short films and writing credits for both fiction and non-fiction television series. Her graduation film, the stop-motion musical *Fish River Anthology* (*Mereneläviä*, 2024), won the National Film Prize Jussi for Best Short Film in 2025. The film was also a favorite of five juries at the Tampere Short Film Festival, where it received multiple distinctions. The film has screened internationally at more than 70 festivals, earning several jury and audience prizes.

COMPANY

Rata Motion Oy is a new creatively driven production company founded by filmmakers **Janne J. Vanhanen** and **Veera Lamminpää**. **Rata Motion** focuses on ambitious audiovisual storytelling and the development of new transmedia concepts across platforms.

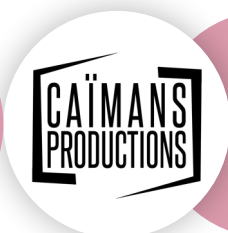
PRODUCER

DIRECTOR
